ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

Greenbank Parish Church is committed to protecting the environment and ensuring that we meet all requirements in terms of environmental sustainability.

The Kirk Session, Congregation and users of the church facilities are expected to support this aim through;

- * Reducing and, where reasonably practicable, recycling any waste arising from our activities
- * Minimising, where reasonably practicable the use of energy, water, resources consumed and waste produced whilst undertaking our activities
- * Supporting the re-use and recycling of materials and ensuring the safe and legal disposal of all waste arising from our activities
- * Complying with our local authority guidelines in waste disposal and, where possible, exceeding these requirements
- * Complying with and, where possible, exceeding the environmental requirements of Church of Scotland and/or Glasgow Presbytery
- * Receiving adequate and appropriate information on environmental matters

Greenbank Parish Church believes that the ongoing development of our environmental policy is fundamental to achieving our aspirations. The Kirk Session will as a minimum review annually the effectiveness of this environmental policy.
